3. Briefly the averments in the plaint are to the effect that one Ramaswami Reddiar, s/o Royal Reddiar was married to one Jayalakshmi, D/o Kesava Reddiar at Thirubuvanai on 10.05.1939, as per Hindu Customs and rites. The same was not registered with the concerned authorities. Out of the said lawful wedlock, they did not have any issues. The said Ramaswami Reddiar and Jayalakshmi, died on 19.12.1998 and 15.09.1984 respectively. The death of the said Ramaswami Reddiar and Jayalakshmi is registered with the concerned Authority. The father and mother of the deceased Ramasami Reddiar and Jayalakshmi predeceased them. The parents of the said Ramasamy Reddiar were blessed with one Sinnasamy Reddiar, who was married to one Kamalam @ Kamalammal on 14.09.1942 at Thirubuvanai. Their marriage was not registered. Out of the lawful wedlock plaintiffs 1 to 6 viz., 1. Varadaramanoudjame, 2. Vengadakichenane, 3. Sambassivame, 4. Ramadassou, 5. Sarasuady, 6. Djody were born on 07.12.1946, 18.01.1953, 20.06.1955, 31.08.1957, 12.03.1950 and 19.02.1964 respectively to them. The father and mother of plaintiffs 1 to 6 viz. Sinnasamy Reddiar and Kamalam @ Kamalammal also died on 17.12.1986 and 03.12.1989 leaving behind the plaintiffs, as their legal heirs. The father and mother of the deceased Sinnasamy Reddiar and Kamalam @ Kamalammal predeceased them. While so, the defendant disputed their legal status. Hence the present suit.

4. The defendant on summons appeared before the court and made endorsement on the plaint that he had no objection in passing the award as prayed for by the plaintiffs

5. To prove the facts alleged in the plaint, the plaintiffs filed a proof affidavit touching upon those above facts. Following exhibits were marked:
